Communicative English in the 21st Century

Course Descriptions:

This 15-hour course is designed to develop students' English listening and speaking skills for daily life communication. Instruction focuses on basic oral communication skills through a variety of different speaking situations including using polite language, asking and giving opinions, expressing likes and dislikes, asking for directions, talking about a past experience and future plans. Communication strategies are provided for effective communication and comprehensibility.

Course Objectives:

By the end of this course, students should be able to:

- 1. get ready for daily life communication of English.
- 2. listen with increasing attention to comprehend simple speech.
- 3. understand and respond appropriately to some routine questions.
- 4. use communication strategies for effective oral communication.
